**RULES FOR SALMON – TROUT FISHING**

**Please note rules on legal bait as no refund of permit will be made.**

1. The bait allowed for salmon fishing will be as follows:-

- Between 3<sup>rd</sup> March and 17<sup>th</sup> June - Fly only
- Between 17<sup>th</sup> June and 15<sup>th</sup> September - Any Legal Method
- Between 15<sup>th</sup> September and 17<sup>th</sup> October - Fly and Spin

No worm fishing at all will be allowed between 3<sup>rd</sup> March and 17<sup>th</sup> June and between 15<sup>th</sup> September and 17<sup>th</sup> October.  
**THIS RULE ALSO APPLIES TO JUNIORS.**

2. **The permitted method of fishing on both banks for all ages for trout shall be artificial fly only**

3. All persons fishing the water shall be in possession of the current Environment Agency Rod Licence.

Junior Fishing restricted to trout only – Junior will mean aged 16 years and under**

5. All persons fishing the Waters shall abide by the byelaws of the Environment Agency and the rules of the Council as set out hereunder.
6. Fishing is allowed between sunset and one hour after dusk.
7. The use of stillwater lures is strictly forbidden on the Town Water.
8. NO PERSON SHALL TAKE MORE THAN 3 TROUT FROM THE FISHERY IN ANY ONE DAY, PROVIDED THAT THIS SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY UNDERSIZED FISH (MINIMUM SIZE 10”) WHICH IS RETURNED IMMEDIATELY TO THE WATER WITH AS LITTLE INJURY AS POSSIBLE.
9. Salmon fishermen have the right to fish through trout fishermen.
10. All fresh water fish caught by the holder of this permit shall be removed from the River provided that this shall not apply to fish placed in a keep net for subsequent removal after termination of the day’s fishing.
11. Permits must be produced on demand to authorised officials of the Council and to authorised wardens.
12. Anyone refusing to show the fish in his possession to any authorised person on demand shall forfeit his permit.
13. Fresh water fish include all fish except salmon, brown trout and sea trout.
