

Footway / Verge Vehicle Crossing - Appeals Procedure

The applicant can appeal against the decision within 21 days of the refusal date, by writing to the Head of Operations, Monmouthshire County Council, PO Box 106, Caldicot, NP26 9AN. Objections outside this period may not be heard. A successful appeal will demonstrate that the basis of the engineering decision was clearly at fault. The result of an appeal will be normally sent to the applicant within 21 days. The first stage of the appeal will be considered by the Section Manager, if the applicant following receipt of this decision is still aggrieved then the applicant can request that it be considered as a stage 2 appeal and should be made within 21 days of the date of the stage 1 decision. The result of a Stage 2 appeal will be normally sent to the applicant within 21 days

Stage 1

If the applicant is dissatisfied with the decision to not grant permission

Referred to the Section Manager

The Section Manager will review the application and the officers decision and inform the applicant of the decision

Stage 2

If the applicant is dissatisfied with the decision made by the Section Manager

Referred to Head of Operations

Head of Infrastructure & Sustainability in conjunction with the Cabinet Member for County Operations will further review the application or an appeal against a decision for a final decision.
