NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO REVIEW THE PREMISES LICENCE: GOYTRE STORES, 1 FAIRFIELD, PENPERLLEN, GOYTRE, MONMOUTHSHIRE.

An application to review the premises licence of Goytre Stores, 1 Fairfield, Penperlleni, Goytre, Monmouthshire under Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 has been submitted to Monmouthshire County Council.

The premises licence currently authorises the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises as prescribed by The Licensing Act 2003.

The grounds for the application are that the premises has undermined the key licensing objectives prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003 in particular the prevention of crime and disorder and the protection of children from harm.

From the date of this notice a 28 day consultation period concludes on the 17/12/2019. Within this time representations may be submitted relevant to the key licensing objectives.
