Project Progress

Over the next few months we will continue with our planned programme of excavation and drainage works and will commence surfacing, paving and kerb installation in Phases 1,2 & 3. All works are subject to weather conditions. We are currently on programme to complete the project at the end of May 2020.

Temporary Road Closure

We have a temporary road closure planned on Sandy Lane joining onto Newport Road commencing at 09.00am on Monday 13th January 2020. The temporary road closure will be place for approximately 8 weeks and will enable us to safely complete service ducting, drainage, paving and reconstruction works to the carriageway. The temporary road closure will be in place on a 24 hour basis and diversion routes will be clearly signposted. We have included a copy of the diversion routes on the reverse of this bulletin.

We ask that you take the temporary road closure into consideration when planning any journeys.
