- bring your own beverages/refreshments due to COVID-19 restrictions we are not able to provide teas/coffees etc.
- to remain at your desk area during the class unless you need to take a comfort break or leave the building.
- to leave the centre promptly once your class has finished the centre will need to be cleaned thoroughly before the next class starts and the staff will have a limited amount of time to ensure this is achieved.
