

My Day, My Life Review Update May 2023

What has happened so far?



We finished writing our report of the My Day, My Life service **review** at the end of March 2023.



A **review** is when we check a plan or how something is working to make sure we are working in the best way.



The report explains what we did, what we found out and what we think should happen next.

We shared the report with people who were involved in the **review**. And then we shared it with the public.



We want to thank everyone who took the time to read the report and send us feedback.



We will look at the report again on 18 July. We will include people's feedback then.

What are we going to do about the recommendations in the report?



The report helped us to understand what is important to the people who use the **My Day My Life** day service and their families. And how they want to see the service improve and change.



We made 9 suggestions in the report.



We will ask the **Monmouthshire County Council Cabinet members** to accept the recommendations.



The **Cabinet** is a group of 8 County Councillors who make decisions about services and policies in Monmouthshire.



We are working on a plan that will set out what steps we need to take to make sure the recommendations are followed.

What next?



We will have a **People Scrutiny Committee** to look into the report we have written.



Scrutiny means to check carefully. We will invite people to check all our work and plans and give feedback.



The **People Scrutiny Committee** will meet on **18 July 2023**.



People and their families who use the **My Day My Life service** and other people can be a part of the **People Scrutiny Committee**.

What will happen at the People Scrutiny Committee



At the meeting, people will have the chance to ask us questions about the **review** and what we found out.



People will also check our action plan. And how we plan to involve people who use the **My Day, My Life** service.



In the meantime **My Day, My Life** services will keep on supporting people in the community as they are.

What about Tudor Street?



Monmouthshire County Council Cabinet said that they would make a decision about the building on Tudor Street after the **review** was completed.



One of our suggestions was that people need to be in safe and **accessible** buildings.



Accessible means it is easy to use and suitable for people with different needs.



We want there to be a safe and **accessible** building in Abergavenny and Monmouth.



We are looking into options for safe **accessible** buildings in these areas. We will update people about our work on this at the **People Scrutiny Committee** on **18 July**.
