NOTICE OF MAKING A PERMANENT ORDER

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Monmouthshire County Council of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA ("the Council") has made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

The order will come into effect on **2nd June 2023**

The **effect of the order** shall be:

To give permanent effect to the provisions contained with the previously introduced Experimental Order below, which was made on **18th November 2021** and which has been successful

BELMONT ROAD & BELMONT CLOSE, ABERGAVENNY, MONMOUTHSHIRE
EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 2021

To implement an experimental Prohibition of Driving (Except for Access) order on the roads identified above to prohibit any vehicle from entering and proceeding along the identified roads except for access to premises within those roads.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the ground that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the effect of the order 2nd June 2023, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
