Who are we?

Adferiad is a member-led charity providing help and support for people who experience mental health, substance use, additional and other complex needs, with the aim of helping individuals to maximise their potential and achieve a better quality of life. You may have previously known us as Hafal, but in 2021 we merged with CAIS and WCADA to form Adferiad.

In Monmouthshire we provide Carers and Family Support to unpaid carers, including Young Carers (14+) and their families, who support someone living with mental health issues. (If you need support with someone suffering from Alzheimer's or dementia, contact Dementia UK and/or Alzheimer's Society.)

Our support is provided by Vicky and Leigh.

About our services

We provide 2 flexible outreach services.

Monmouthshire Carers: for adult unpaid carers of adults (16+) with a mental health illness. Monmouthshire Family Support service for any family member who is involved in the care of a person dealing with mental ill health, this includes a Young Carer (14+).

The support offered includes:

- Information and Advice
- Help to access a Carers Assessment
- Signposting to other sources of support
- Respite opportunities
- Advocacy support
- Emotional support
- Peer support
- Carers Groups
- Young Carers support
- Family support and communication

How can you get support?

If you are looking for some support in your caring role we are here to help. There is currently no waiting list, and you can self-refer with the information below. Referrals can also be made from Primary and Secondary Care teams, friends, family or your GP.

GWENT PARENT CARER NETWORK

The Gwent Parent Carer Network supports the parent carers of children and young people with disabilities across the Gwent region of Wales through peer-topeer online support; also running workshops, events and family activities in Monmouthshire.

We were previously known as MAGIC, but have recently changed our name to Gwent Parent Carer Network so that more parent carers easily can find us and know what we do. The group has recently celebrated it's 10th birthday and were also given full charitable status in May 2023 (no. 1203201). We are still wholly volunteer run by parent carers, and all trustees are parent carers too.

YOUNG CARERS IN SCHOOLS PROGRAMME

What is the Young Carers in Schools Programme?

This free of charge programme is designed to help schools 'understand, inform, identify, support, and listen to young carers in a way that meets their needs best. Through the provision of tools and resources schools can ensure young carers have the same opportunities as their peers. Schools receive awards for achieving each stage of the programme: 'Basics, Beyond the Basics and Best Practice'. Each stage requires a school to put in place more robust processes, alongside their current practice. This embeds support for young carers within their school setting. Young Carers from across Gwent participate in a review panel to scrutinise a school's portfolio of evidence, thus ensuring a fair process.

In Monmouthshire, we have 20 Primary Schools and 4 Secondary Schools working towards the Young Carers in Schools Programme. This school year, Durand Primary School in Caldicot achieved both 'The Basics and Beyond the Basics' of the programme in one panel. This was a first for Monmouthshire. We have created bi-lingual information posters about the Young Carers in Schools Programme, which allows us to share succinct information with schools and to raise awareness through our Social Media platforms.

Young Carers in Schools Programme
