TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Monmouthshire County Council of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA ("the Council") has made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

The order will come into effect on **15th September 2023**

The **effect of the order** shall be:

To give permanent effect to the provisions contained with the previously introduced Experimental Order below, which was made on **12th January 2022** and which has been successful

**CROSS STREET AND MARKET STREET, ABERGAVENNY, MONMOUTHSHIRE
(EXPERIMENTAL) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

To implement an experimental Prohibition of Driving (Except for Access) order on the roads identified above to prohibit any vehicle from entering and proceeding along the identified roads except for access to premises within those roads. This Prohibition of Driving (except for access) Order shall be operative from 10 am to 4 pm, Monday to Saturday.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the ground that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the effect of the order 15th September 2023, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
