<p><u>MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> <u>Traffic Regulation, Speed Limits and Parking</u> <u>Regulations Consolidation Order 2019 (20 mph</u> <u>Provisions Revocation Order) 2024</u></p> <p>PROVISION OF AND AMENDMENTS TO TRAFFIC ORDERS WITHIN VARIOUS COMMUNITIES IN MONMOUTHSHIRE</p> <p>Monmouthshire County Council (the 'Council') in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the '1984 Act') and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the '2004' Act) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:</p> <p>1 CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT</p> <p>This Order shall come into operation on..... and may be cited as the Monmouthshire County Council Traffic Regulation, Speed Limits and Parking Regulations Consolidation Order 2019 (20 mph Provisions Revocation Order) 2024</p> <p>2 EFFECT</p> <p>The effect of the order is to revoke provisions in previous orders that introduced 20 mph speed limits on restricted roads now been superseded and made redundant by the coming into force of The Restricted Road (20 mph Speed Limit) (Wales) Order 2022.</p> <p>3 THE ORDER</p> <p>Monmouthshire County Council Traffic Regulation, Speed Limits and Parking Regulations Consolidation Order 2019 is amended by the revocation of provisions in the following amendments to that order.</p> <p>The revocation of the 20 mph provisions introduced in the plans referenced below and included in the schedule to this order.
