

BUDGET 2024/2025



It is the Police and Crime Commissioner's responsibility to set the part of your council tax that contributes towards Gwent Police's annual budget.

The budget for 2024/25 has been determined following detailed scrutiny of the operational and financial case put forward by Chief Constable Pam Kelly. It was also informed by a 12-week programme of public engagement with residents.

The increase of 7.7 per cent (about £2.08 a month on average) is a compromise between affordability for residents and the money needed to continue to run an efficient and effective police service. Thank you to everyone who completed a survey and shared their views.
