NOTICE OF MAKING A PERMANENT ORDER

**MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(20 MPH PROVISIONS REVOCATION ORDER) 2024**

**PROVISION AND OF AMENDMENTS TO TRAFFIC
ORDERS WITHIN VARIOUS COMMUNITIES IN MONMOUTHSHIRE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Monmouthshire County Council of County Hall, The Rhadyr, Usk, NP15 1GA ("the Council") has made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

EFFECT OF THE ORDER:

To revoke previously enacted 20 mph speed limit orders on restricted roads in various communities in the county of Monmouthshire. These speed limit orders are now redundant as they have been superseded by the coming into force of The Restricted Road (20 mph Speed Limit) (Wales) Order 2022.

There is no material effect on the speed limits currently in place. This affects the communities of: Portskewett, Magor with Undy, Abergavenny, Caldicot, Caerwent, Rogiet, Devauden, Chepstow, Monmouth, Raglan, Wye Valley, Usk and Llanbadoc.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the ground that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from 31.04.2024 (being the date that the Order was made), apply for that purpose to the High Court.
