Programme Information

- A six-session programme for parents and carers of autistic children aged 4 to 10 years, or who are going through the diagnostic process.
- We also aim to invite a school staff member who works with or supports their child.
- Optional home contact during programme.
- Programme workbook to go with the programme.



Content & Aims:

- Understanding autism; communication; understanding autistic experiences; supporting daily living; health and wellbeing & connections.
- Join with other parents & professionals to share experiences.
- Build consistency and communication with all.

Where & When

Online programme or face to face programme delivery available. Face to face programme delivered in County Hall Usk in the autumn term over six weeks. Online delivery usually in summer term. Option for additional programme in spring term depending on demand.

I have been part of a team delivering the EarlyBird Plus programme in Monmouthshire since 2014. Ruth Davies - Early Years Additional Learning Needs Advisory Teacher

I joined Monmouthshire Local Authority working within, and then managing, the Specific Learning Difficulties Team. I also became the Early Years Special Educational Needs Liaison Officer, working with Monmouthshire non-maintained settings. From September 2021, I became one of the Early Years Additional Learning Needs Advisory Teachers, working exclusively within this area. I have a wide range of teaching experience and have worked with young people with a range of differences, including those with Autism. I trained to deliver EarlyBird Plus in 2014 and have been helping deliver the programme since then each year. It is great working with parents and other professionals to help them through EarlyBird Plus.

Tanya Walters – Educational Psychologist

I have worked with children and young people with autism and communication needs for over 25 years, both as a teacher and as an EP. I have been working with Monmouthshire EPS since January 2020 and have run several in-person and online EB+ courses.
