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Section 1: Introduction and Context

Introduction

1.1. This report has been prepared by Tyler Grange Group Ltd on behalf of Monmouthshire County Council. It sets out the results of wintering bird surveys (WBS), completed at the site between December 2023 and March 2024 at the land east of Crick Road, Caldicot, Monmouthsire, NP26 5UT. (OS Grid Reference ST 49213 89303), hereafter referred to as 'the site'. See Figure 1.1 for the indicative red line boundary.

Purpose

1.2. This report:

- Presents the results of wintering bird surveys completed at the site between December 2023 and March 2024.
- Discusses further survey work in respect to birds and in line with the current guidance, in order to inform a future planning application.



Section 2: Methodology

Wintering Bird Surveys

- 2.1. The survey methodology followed guidance produced by the Bird Survey & Assessment Steering Group for non-breeding bird surveys¹. The objective of the surveys was to identify the scale and distribution of non-breeding bird populations within/adjacent to the site and the areas that they favour.
- 2.2. The survey area comprised the red line boundary that is scheduled for development (see **Plan 16528/P01)** plus 100m in all directions around the site where access/views permitted.
- 2.3. The surveys covered the core winter period; commencing in December 2023 and concluding in March 2024, with one visit completed each month.
- 2.4. Although the same survey route was used during all visits, the starting point and survey direction were alternated during each survey so that all areas were covered at varied times to ensure even coverage during the peak period of bird activity.
- 2.5. The conservation status of the birds observed was ascertained through consultation of national, regional and local bird reports.
- 2.6. Dates, times and weather conditions are presented below in **Table 2.1**.

Section 3: Wintering Bird Survey Results

Wintering Bird Surveys

3.1. 37 bird species were recorded onsite/immediately adjacent to the site during the surveys, from December to March. Of these, 16 are species of Conservation Concern, with peak numbers and frequency of recordings highlighted in **Table 3.3.**

Section 4: Further Work

4.1. Following the completion of the wintering bird surveys, Tyler Grange are completing breeding bird surveys at the site. Surveys for breeding birds on site are scheduled to take place from March onwards, as set out in **Table 4.1** below.

Survey	Visits and Timings
Birds	Breeding bird surveys spread evenly between March and July, with at least one visit to be conducted in the evening. Breeding bird surveys are already scheduled for completion commencing in March 2024.

4.4. A second technical note will be produced in July 2024, presenting the results of the breeding bird surveys. These surveys would inform any future planning application and allow the site to be developed in accordance with relevant planning policy and legislation.






