## Section 4: Declarations (see note 5)

**Note 5:** The first two declarations reflect the requirements set out in section 16(A1) of the Government of Wales Act 2006 which prescribes the circumstances in which (by reference to Schedule 1A to that Act) a person is disqualified from being a member of Senedd Cymru and from being a candidate to be a member of the Senedd. The second declaration relates to paragraph 8 of Schedule 1A to the Government of Wales Act 2006 which prescribes that a person may not be a member of Senedd Cymru or a candidate to be a member of Senedd Cymru unless they are registered in the register of local government electors at an address within a Senedd constituency.

The third declaration reflects the requirements in section 7 of the Government of Wales Act 2006 which prescribes that a person may only stand once as a candidate at a general election. As such a party list candidate may only be included on one party list, and may not be included on any other list (whether in the same constituency or another). A party list candidate may also not stand as an individual candidate (again, whether in the same constituency or another). Similarly, a person may not be an individual candidate if they also appear on any party list, or as an individual candidate in any other constituency.
