An application to review the premises licence of the Railway Inn, 32 Brecon Road, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire, NP7 5UG, under Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 has been submitted to Monmouthshire County Council, Licensing Section.

The Licence currently authorises the sale of alcohol and the provision of Late Night refreshment on the premises as prescribed by The Licensing Act 2003

The grounds for the application are that the premises breaches one or more of the four licensing objectives, The Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety, The Prevention of Public Nuisance, The Protection of Children from prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.
